SBA's Deadline for Physical Damage Disaster Loans for Private Non-Profit Organizations in New Jersey is January 4

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration is reminding eligible private non-profit (PNP) organizations in New Jersey of the **Jan. 4** deadline to submit disaster loan applications for damages caused by Hurricane Sandy. Examples of eligible non-critical PNP organizations include, but are not limited to food kitchens, homeless shelters, museums, libraries, community centers, schools and colleges.

The SBA offers low interest disaster loans to private non-profit organizations for physical losses up to its loan limits. Approved loans can be increased for protective measures to lessen similar future damages. Additionally, PNPs can obtain loans for unmet working capital needs. To be considered for this assistance, PNPs need to apply by the deadline.

These loans are available to PNPs located in Atlantic, Bergen, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Essex, Gloucester, Hudson, Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Morris, Ocean, Passaic, Salem, Somerset, Sussex, Union and Warren counties in **New Jersey**. Applicants may apply online using the Electronic Loan Application (ELA) via SBA's secure website at SBA's website at <https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela>.

The filing deadline to return applications for physical property damage is **January 4, 2013**. The deadline to return economic injury applications is **August 5, 2013**.
