## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 11754

## OFFERED BY MR. SMITH OF NEW JERSEY

Add at the end of subtitle F of title X of division A the following:

1	SEC GAO REVIEW AND REPORT ON BIOLOGICAL
2	WEAPONS EXPERIMENTS ON AND IN RELA-
3	TION TO TICKS, TICK-BORNE DISEASE.
4	(a) REVIEW.—The Comptroller General of the United
5	States shall conduct a review of research conducted during
6	the period beginning on January 1, 1945, and ending on
7	December 31, 1970, by the Department of Defense, in-
8	cluding by the Department of Defense in consultation with
9	the National Institutes of Health, the Department of Agri-
0	culture, or any other Federal agency on—
11	(1) the use of ticks as hosts or delivery mecha-
12	nisms for biological warfare agents, including experi-
13	ments involving Spirochaetales and Rickettsiales;
14	and
15	(2) any efforts to improve the effectiveness and
16	viability of Spirochaetales and Rickettsiales as bio-
17	logical weapons through combination with other dis-
18	eases or viruses.

1	(b) LOCATION OF RESEARCH.—In conducting the re-
2	view under subsection (a), the Comptroller General shall
3	review research conducted at facilities located inside
4	United States and facilities located outside the United
5	States, including laboratories and field work locations.
6	(e) REVIEW OF CLASSIFIED INFORMATION.—In con-
7	ducting the review under subsection (a), the Comptroller
8	General shall review any relevant classified information.
9	(d) REPORT.—Not later than 18 months after the
10	date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
11	shall submit to Congress a report, which shall be sub-
12	mitted in unclassified form, but may include a classified
13	annex, that includes the following:
14	(1) the scope of any research described in sub-
15	section (a); and
16	(2) whether any ticks used in such research
17	were released outside of any facility (including any
18	ticks that were released unintentionally); and
19	(3) whether any records related to such re-
20	search were destroyed, and whether such destruction
21	was intentional or unintentional.

6	SEC. 6493. REVIEW AND REPORT OF EXPERIMENTATION
7	WITH TICKS AND INSECTS.
8	(a) REVIEW.—The Comptroller General of the United
9	States shall conduct a review of whether the Department
0	of Defense experimented with ticks, other insects, airborne
11	releases of tick-borne bacteria, viruses, pathogens, or any
12	other tick-borne agents regarding use as a biological weap-
13	on between the years of 1950 and 1977.
14	(b) REPORT.—If the Comptroller General of the
15	United States finds that any experiment described under
16	subsection (a) occurred, the Comptroller General shall
17	submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the House
18	of Representatives and the Senate a report on—
19	(1) the scope of such experiment; and
20	(2) whether any ticks, insects, or other vector-
21	borne agents used in such experiment were released
22	outside of any laboratory by accident or experiment
23	design.
