Mr. Smith of New Jersey (for himself, Mr. Mast, and Mr. Wilson of South Carolina) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

## A BILL

To prohibit aid that will benefit Hamas, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stop Support for
- 5 United Nations Relief and Works Agency Act of 2024"
- 6 or the "Stop Support for UNRWA Act of 2024".
- 7 SEC. 2. UNITED STATES CONTRIBUTIONS TO UNRWA.
- 8 The United States may not make any voluntary or
- 9 assessed contributions to the United Nations Relief and
- 10 Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East

1	(referred to in this Act as "UNRWA"), to any successor
2	or related entity, or to the regular budget of the United
3	Nations for the support of UNRWA or a successor entity.
4	SEC. 3. NONPRECLUSION OF HUMANITARIAN ASSIST-
5	ANCE.
6	Nothing in this Act may be construed to preclude the
7	provision of humanitarian assistance through any agency
8	or entity other than UNRWA to individuals or entities
9	that also receive assistance from UNRWA if the Secretary
10	of State certifies to Congress that such other agency or
11	entity—
12	(1) does not promote, espouse, or affiliate w
13	entities or individuals that promote violence, ter-
14	rorism, or antisemitism, as such term is defined by
15	the IHRA Working Definition of Antisemitism; and
16	(2) does not employ individuals who promo
17	espouse, or affiliate with such entities or individuals.
