I have served as the Vice Chair to the Monmouth Ocean Foundation for Children (MOFFC), a nonprofit that focuses exclusively on financially supporting programs that will enhance the lives of students diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD), for the past several years. In addition, adults will also continue to have access to valuable services, such as behavioral therapies, speech, occupational and physical therapy and life skills programming so that they can continue to grow and develop independent life skills, which will greatly enrich their lives and our communities.

Thank you for your consideration in reviewing the Achieve Academy for Adults with Autism's request. I am proud to recommend them for federal funding and look forward to the impact these improvements will have on the Monmouth County community.
