- 3 SECTION 1. OUTPATIENT CLINIC, SOUTHERN NEW JERSEY.
- 4 (a) In General.—The Administrator of Veterans' Af-
- 5 fairs shall establish and operate, as part of the Department of
- 6 Medicine and Surgery of the Veterans' Administration, an
- 7 outpatient clinic in southern New Jersey.
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—This section shall take effect
- 9 on October 1, 1985.
