I write to you today to respectfully request that federal funding for the **Mercer County Roadway Safety Improvements** (DB #D0412) project be included in the 2021 Surface Transportation Authorization legislation.

As a project currently listed on the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Fiscal Years 2020-2023 and sponsored by Mercer County, this project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars as it will help fund several necessary roadway improvements in Mercer County, New Jersey.
