
Please accept this as a letter of support for the Borough of Bay Head Flood Mitigation Project.



Flooding in Bay Head continues to be a significant problem, not only for the residents of Bay Head, but also for residents and visitors to the Barrier Island where Bay Head is located. Ocean County has recently supported Bay Head in upgrading flood control measures for two County Roads passing through the Borough, but more work is needed.

This letter forwards the full support and endorsement of the Bay Head Environmental Commission for the Bay Head Flood Mitigation Project proposed to be added to the list of projects for Homeland Security Committee appropriations.

The Bay Head Environmental Commission has conducted a comprehensive assessment of flood conditions in the Borough for the past three years and has developed a detailed Action Plan to mitigate flooding. The installation of a tidal flood control gate on Scow Ditch and raising the shoreline of Twilight Lake are key elements of the Plan to mitigate flooding. The Environmental Commission Flood Subgroup has studied these actions in detail and has developed a detailed scope, cost estimate, and schedule for this project. Implementation of this Project will reduce the risk of loss/damage of property in Bay Head. It will also assure safe and reliable use of streets throughout Bay Head that now flood during a major storm, greatly restricting, if not preventing, access to critical infrastructure like the Fire Station, Police Station, Emergency Communications Equipment, Town Hall, and the Sewer Pumping Station. Safe and reliable use of the east-west and north-south backup emergency evacuation routes through Bay Head will also be improved by mitigating flooding on the streets that are used for evacuation of the Barrier Island.

The Bay Head Flood Mitigation Project is considered a critical project within Bay Head for safety and loss prevention. It is highly recommended this Project be funded.
