3 SECTION 1. OFFSHORE WIND ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW
4 PROCESS STUDY.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.— No later than 60 days after 6 the enactment of this bill, the Comptroller General 7 shall conduct a study to assess the sufficiency of the 8 environmental review processes for offshore wind projects 9 in place as of the date of the enactment of this section of **SMITNJ\SMITNJ**

2 Ocean Energy Management, and any other relevant

3 Federal agency.

4 (b) CONTENTS.—The study required under sub-5 section (a) shall include consideration of—

(1) the impacts of offshore wind projects on 6 whales, finfish, marine mammals, benthic 7 resources, commercial and recreational fishing, air quality and 8 greenhouse gas emissions, cultural, historical, and 9 archaeological resources, invertebrates, and essential 10 fish habitat, military use and navigation/vessel traffic; 11 recreation and tourism, and sustainability of 12 shoreline beaches and inlets; 13

14 (2) how the agencies determines which

15 stakeholders are consulted and if a timely,

16 comprehensive comment period is provided for local

17 representatives and interested parties; and

18 (3) the estimated cost and who pays for the19 offshore wind projects.
